Current & Future State of U.S. Housing Market

What: Robert J. Shiller, Professor of Economics, Yale University and Chief Economist, MacroMarkets LLC, and David Blitzer, Managing Director and Chairman of the Index Committee, Standard & Poor's, will discuss the current state and future of the U.S. housing market via a live webinar on Tuesday, November 27th at 10am eastern time.

Professor Shiller will explore U.S. housing trends that have developed over the past 20 years, recent developments that are impacting home prices, as well as current trends within residential real estate.
